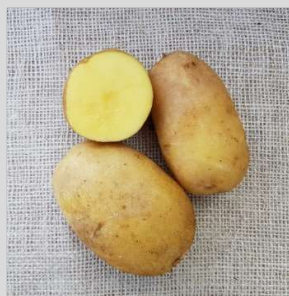


# Titanium

It can be supplied all year round. The high level of nematode resistance makes the variety very valuable in crop-rotation. The variety is low-input and high-output.

## Cultivation and storage (point of attention)

Seed treatment	Warm temperature helps quick emergence
Plot selection	Most soils are suitable
Fertilisation	N-- P+ K+++
Planting	Wider planting distance and can be planted deeper
Cultivation	Moderate fertilisation to achieve an early crop
Metribuzin	Sensitive (5)
Harvesting	Harvest mature product and pay attention to bruising
Storage	Dry quickly and keep dry by ventilating
Handling	No problems with handling
Point of Attention	Avoid bruising at harvesting. Sensitive to wind during growth.
