Seed treatment	Good pre-sprouting, to prevent apical dominance
Plot selection	Suitable for all kinds of soils
Fertilisation	N -- P+ K++
Planting	Average to narrow planting distance
Cultivation	Average emergence with very good coverage of foliage
Metribuzin	Not susceptible (7)
Harvesting	Take time between haulm killing and harvest, to set skin
Storage	Good ventilation
Handling	Low failure rate
Point of Attention	Important that growth is as even as possible; without growth disorders
