## Cultivation and storage (point of attention)

Seed treatment	Normal treatment
Plot selection	Good water management is desirable
Fertilisation	N+++ P+ K+ Mg++ Bo++
Planting	Not too early, average depth and slightly wider planting
Cultivation	Quickly covered crop. Irrigation is preferred
Metribuzin	Average sensitive (6)
Harvesting	Harvest is possible soon because of quick maturity
Storage	Dry quickly, to keep silver scab under control
Handling	Very low percentage of waste
Point of Attention	Avoid leaving them in the soil for skin set. The skin appear netted.
