Seed treatment	Good pre-sprouting in required
Plot selection	Can be grown on all kinds of soils
Fertilisation	N -- P+ K ± Mg +
Planting	Slightly narrow planting
Cultivation	Good structure of soil is required
Metribuzin	Not susceptible (7)
Harvesting	No problems expected
Storage	Ventilate some hours per day to keep humidity at right level
Handling	Good in handling
Point of Attention	The variety characteristics in combination with 100% healthy seed make this variety a winner
